Members of Multicultural Sorority Visit New Mexico for a Weekend of Business and Fellowship

Albuquerque, NM – August 2008 – Women from all walks of life will converge upon Albuquerque, NM from September 4-7 for the 10th Annual Convention of Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority, Inc. Business meetings, educational and professional seminars, personal development and social activities, and service to the Albuquerque community comprise the weekend event.

This year's keynote speaker will be Mary Molina Mescall, the Executive Director of the New Mexico Commission on the Status of Women. Members of the community are also invited to attend the 2nd Annual Multicultural Showcase, "Enchanted ONederland," in the ballroom at the University of New Mexico on Friday, September 5th. Doors open at 7:30pm and admission is free.
